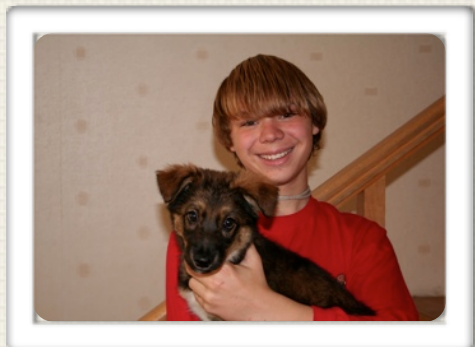


THE ANDERSONS

--- we just finished our fourth Field Forum and since that first year our team has grown by six families and a single lady (13 adults, 17 kids!)

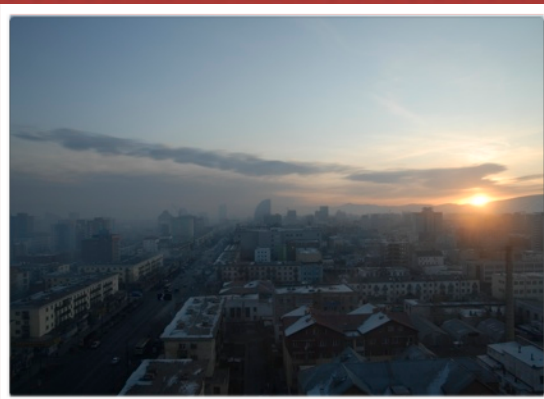
BACK IN 2006 ...
